5. Use a piece of scrap pattern paper in your collage or as a background
6. After you create a collage with your 5 prompts, add a sticker or a rubber stamping to embellish it, if you'd like

- *Bonus: A rubber stamping in 2 colors

- ✓ A bug or insect
- ✓ A key
- ✓ A sequence of numbers
- ✓ "Ink" - whatever that means to you
- ✓ A quote
- *Bonus: Something in black and white

- ✓ A playing card, either side
- ✓ A group of three
- ✓ Something with a bumpy surface
- ✓ Something that splashes
- ✓ Buttons - real, drawn, or stamped
- *Bonus: A person/people

- ✓ A path or road
- ✓ Something cold
- ✓ A favorite word
- ✓ A piece of calendar
- ✓ Paper with a repeating pattern
- *Bonus: An illustration

- ✓ Something ornate
- ✓ A piece of dictionary page
- ✓ Something that turns or spins
- ✓ Something that starts with C
- ✓ A form or portion--blank or filled
- *Bonus: Something you see through the window

- ✓ A leaf or leaves
- ✓ Something sweet
- ✓ A group of three
- ✓ A math symbol
- ✓ A doodle
- *Bonus: A label

- ✓ A person or people
- ✓ Bubbles
- ✓ A crossword or newspaper/
magazine puzzle
- ✓ Text not in English or your native
language
- ✓ Sticker from a fruit or vegetable
- *Bonus: The next noun you hear
someone saying, in any form

- ✓ A piece of jewelry
- ✓ something green
- ✓ paper with lines on it
- ✓ something found in a desk
- ✓ something drawn in ink
- *Bonus: a security envelope pattern

#2020c10

- ✓ Something you see through a window
- ✓ something you can hold in your hand
- ✓ A mushroom or small flower
- ✓ A poem or portion of
- ✓ A piece of dictionary page
- *Bonus: A geometric shape
